



# Solar oven S'mores

Make a solar oven and use the Sun's energy to cook a S'more.

## You'll need:

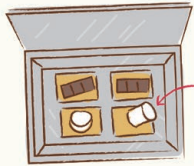
- 1 Cut the flaps off the top of your Tinker Crate box.



- 2 Prop the top open and line the inside of the box with aluminum foil. Use clear tape to hold it in place.



- 3 Put four graham cracker halves in the box. Place a marshmallow on two of the crackers and a piece of chocolate on the rest.



- 4 Cover the box opening with plastic wrap and tape it down.



- 5 Place your box in a sunny spot for about 20 minutes or until the chocolate starts to melt.



If your lid is closing, use a straw and some tape to prop it open.

- 6 Enjoy your Sun-cooked s'mores!
