# Claw Vocabulary

Think about these vocab words as you build with your group! You can take notes or check these words off the list whenever you see them for the first time.

	<b>finger mount</b>	A piece in your claw that connects a finger with the handle. It's dark gray and only has one pair of holes.
	<b>joint</b> <i>(also known as articulation)</i>	A connection between two parts. In your claw, it's where a rubber band connects two joint pieces. In your body, a joint connects two bones.
	<b>tension</b>	The pull force of a string or string-like thing.
	<b>friction</b>	A force that fights slipping and sliding. In your claw, the rubber squares on the finger pads create friction.
	<b>dexterity</b>	How quickly or well you can do something with your hands. You need dexterity to pick up small items, sew, and type.
